Player Registration terms and conditions 2023/2024

Conditions of signing on:

By enrolling the player named on the registration document you wish to become a member of ALMONDSBURY UNITED FOOTBALL CLUB for the forthcoming season, 1st August 2023 to 31st July 2024.

By doing this we are agreeing to follow and respect the below conditions set by the club and to pay the relevant sign on fee and Subs for your child's age group set out in the table below.

Please read this information carefully:

Code of Conduct: I agree that the named player be bound by the laws and resolutions of the Football Association, its constituent bodies and the rules of Almondsbury United FC. I agree to abide by and will ensure that any additional spectators linked to us, also abide by the Club and FA Code of Conduct for Players and Spectators. Available to view on our website.

We ask all players, parents/guardians, coaches & additional spectators linked to a club player, to act in a respectful manner at all times when attending any games, training or activities involving Almondsbury United FC.

The use of foul or abusive language or threat of violence towards any Match official, opposition player, coach, spectator, Almondsbury coaches, players, committee or fellow parents will not be tolerated and is not within the ethos of the club. As such any incidents could lead to the individual(s) being suspended from Almondsbury United activities or asked to leave the club. Any such action will be decided by the committee following a full investigation. Individuals, who break FA code of conduct rules, may also be subject to investigation by the county FA. If found guilty said individuals could be fined and / or banned from all footballing activities.

Attending games: All persons who are not part of the Coaching team or players must spectate in the designated area, behind the Respect barrier only. No parent/guardian or spectators are to stand behind goals or in any other area around the pitch unless asked to do so by a match official or coach.

Payment of Sign on fee & Subs: We offer 2 payment options:

Option 1: Pay sign on and subs separately.

Sign on fee paid by bank transfer & subs paid by direct debit split evenly over season.

Option 2: Pay Full total (sign on & subs together) by bank transfer

(If paying in full payment must be received before you child can play any competitive matches)

If a player leaves,

- Sign on fee is non-refundable,
- If the full amount has been paid, a refund will be calculated on number of whole months remaining of the seasons plan. Part months will not be refunded.
- If paying by direct debit, the direct debit will be cancelled from the next payment due date.

I agree to pay all sign on fee and subs for my child's age group as outlined in this year's payment schedule. I understand that failure to make the required payments, will mean my child or children will not be permitted to participate in any Almondsbury United activities until payment has been received in full. If a player leaves the club without paying all outstanding fees, the club hold the right to object to any transfer to another club until outstanding fees are paid in full.

Data Protection: I acknowledge Almondsbury United FC need participants' and members' personal data to be able to run the football club and arrange matches; to administer memberships and provide the membership services you are signing up to when you register with the club. I consent to the holding, use or disclosure of such data by Almondsbury United FC. We treat all personal data in an appropriate and lawful manner, in accordance with the EU General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679 (GDPR). Set out in our data protection policy and privacy notice, available to view on our website.

Football Kit: Any match day football kit issued by Almondsbury United FC remains the property of the club. In order to maintain an environmentally friendly and sustainable club, Almondsbury United FC requires that all kit be returned if your child leaves the club for any reason, or when collecting replacement kit (unless otherwise agreed with the committee) the club hold the right to object to any transfer to another club until any non-returned kit has been returned to the club.

Images: At times the Club may wish to take photos or videos of the team or individuals in it. We adhere to The FA Guidelines to ensure these are safe and respectful and used solely for the purposes for which they are intended, which is promotion and celebration of the activities of the Club.
